PREFACE

The Union Mountainbike Club Koppl has been welcoming its participants, spectators and sponsors to its mountain bike races since 1998. In 2023 we want to organize an unforgettable race weekend again. For the first time on Saturday, September 23rd, 2023 we will host a UCI race for juniors (part of the Mountainbike Liga Austria) and elite women/men (UCI) in addition to the Austria Youngsters Cup organized by the Austrian Cycling Association (ÖRV). In the evening, from 5:00 p.m., we'll have a party (PDF) including the (overall) award ceremony. The event takes place at the bike park near the technical assistance zone (TAZ). Keep the evening and night free and let us surprise you with what we have planned for our 25th anniversary! On Sunday, September 24th, 2023 we welcome our friends from the Bavarian Cycling Association (BRV) with the Pölzcup racing series and the Salzburg State Cycling Association (LRV SBG) with the Junior Bike Cup Salzburg.

Further information should make your race preparations easier. These include information on **how to get here and the venue** (PDF) as well as recommendations for **accommodation** (PDF). The **program** of the event (Saturday) will then follow on site after the **bib number delivery** (PDF). The **Technical Guide** summarizes all the necessary information for Saturday. The races in the individual race categories and **race tracks** (Saturday) can be followed via **live timing** (Saturday) on the Internet. The **results** are available online on Saturday immediately after verification by the responsible race steward. During the entire program we will provide you with food and drinks in the clubhouse (PDF). For those who want to stay a little longer on site before and/or after the race, shopping facilities and other information related to the race are also included in the FAQ (PDF).

As part of the sustainable use of environmental resources, it is important to us at the Union Mountainbike Club Koppl to subordinate the upcoming Nockstein Trophy to the main criteria of a "green event" as far as possible. In a modern understanding, sustainability includes the harmony of people, nature, and economy. To avoid mountains of rubbish and traffic avalanches, we (particularly spectators) refer to the use of environmentally friendly means of travel and the formation of carpools.

The Union Mountainbike Club Koppl, on behalf of the board and its entire team, wishes everyone good preparation and a stress-free journey, as well as an injury-free and successful race!

1 THE NOCKSTEIN TROPHY

The 25th Nockstein Trophy, held about ten kilometers east of the city of Salzburg, is part of the Austria Youngsters Cup and the Mountainbike Liga Austria 2023. The Nockstein Trophy is the final race for both series. Accordingly, at the end of the day's award ceremony, the overall award ceremony in the respective cup will also take place. For the juniors and the elite men and women, the Nockstein Trophy is run as a UCI C2 race.

Our cross-country route (PDF) has been further modified by us over the last few years and adapted to the style of a cross-country competition. The new route thus reduces long climbs. The total length of the route was also reduced to around 3.8 kilometers. This not only increases the attractiveness for the spectators through an increased number of laps, but also enables starters with a breakdown to reach the technical zone more quickly (see PDF). The athletes come here twice per lap.

We wish all participants every success and hope that the documents provided will enable them to travel to the event without any problems.

1.4 RACE INFORMATION & RULES

Announcement: The event is announced via the ÖRV calendar with the approval number (83-2/20230628). Furthermore, the UCI C2 race will be announced on the UCI calendar. There is also relevant information on the event website: https://www.nocksteintrophy.at. The current sports regulations of the UCI apply to the implementation and participation. Helmets are compulsory. The sporting supervision is taken over by the UCI. The organizer reserves the right to make any changes to the schedule in consultation with the race directors. Participation is at your own risk, considering all the content set out in the organizer's conditions of participation. Technical defects in the equipment, leaving the signposted routes and violations of the rules lead to disqualification. Each participant takes care of their own insurance cover.

Racing Rules:

- Austria Youngsters Cup: According to ÖRV guidelines and its MTB racing regulations as well as the ÖRV fee schedule.
- Juniors and Elite: UCI regulations

Mode: Cross Country (XCO), Austria Youngsters Cup, UCI C2 Juniors/Elite

Starting line-up: According to the current ranking list from the ÖRV and the UCI.

1.6 RACE PREPARTATION

Programme: The detailed program provides an overview of the daily routine.

Registration: The following LINK leads to online registration. Opening lastest from 01.08.2023 10:00 p.m. until the closing date for entries.

Entry deadline: Tuesday, September 19, 2023 | 22:00 hrs

Late entry: Late entry is on site. Registration is possible until one hour before the start of the race. Late entries will be rowed up at the end of the starting line-up!

Late registration fee: Late registrations are possible if you pay double the entry fee!

Entry fee (according to the ÖRV fee schedule):

U13-U17: €11.00 Juniors: € 19.00 Elite: €35.00

Payment: The entry fee is only to be paid upon registration (collecting the start number). Please <u>do NOT transfer the money</u>!

Participant list: LINK to entry list

Start list: LINK to the start list (accessible for the first time after the entry deadline on the notice board on site)

License: Show the UCI license (link to current ÖRV licenses) when registering without being asked!

Enrolment (start number issue): In the clubhouse from 7:30 a.m. until one hour before the last start (LINK).

Conditions of participation: The conditions of participation set out on the website and confirmed with the online registration apply, including the disclaimer! In doing so, you consider the official requirements or agreements with the landowners associated with this event. These do not allow mountain biking on the route outside of the route inspection times and the stated race times. The Union Mountainbike Club Koppl cannot be made responsible for any fine expressed by the landowners or by the authorities! In addition, the UCI/ÖRV race directors reserve the right to punish violations with start disqualifications.

Weather conditions: Conditions can change fast in Koppl. Observe the weather forecast and the rain radar to optimise your equipment.

Race tracks: The location of the race tracks including the elevation profile are shown in the document https://www.nocksteintrophy.at/racetrack. The actual route can still be changed due to weather conditions or the responsible race director!

Track Inspection: Between 7:30 - 09:00 and a second time from 10:45 - 11:15. Note: The start number must be attached to the handlebars during the course inspection. Driving on the track during a running race is forbidden and will be sanctioned with a race exclusion!!!

Team Manager Meeting: All information will be posted on site or are available online. There will be no Team Manager Meeting!

Technical Assistance Zone (TAZ): The TAZ is shown in the route maps. It can be operated on the right and left side on both directions. The ÖRV/UCI regulations apply!

Starting line-up (call up): 15 minutes before the race in the designated area in front of the starting line.



Start times: see chapter 1.7!

Objections: Objections can be made up to U17 according to ÖRV criteria. The regulations of the UCI apply to the juniors and the elite class.

Medical care: The Salzburg Red Cross is available on site. The hospitals in the area are shown in the FAQ.

Anti-doping: The doping rules of the UCI, ÖRV and the Austrian Anti-Doping Act of 2021 apply and may be checked on site by NADA.

Changing rooms/showers: On the ground floor of the clubhouse.

Bike Wash: At the beginning of the gravel parking lot in front of the soccer field.

1.7 STARTING TIMES OF THE RACES

The program of events is divided into two events for the ÖRV-approved cross-country race (1st Austria Youngsters Cup, 2nd UCI C2 race juniors and elite). The schedule and content of the program shown in Table 1 is the planning basis, which can be modified at short notice on site by the race management (Joel Obodov et al.). The races of the different age groups take place SUCCESSIVELY. To avoid delays in the process, the times given are to be seen as guidelines. Please pay attention to the loudspeaker announcements of the moderators, when exactly an age group will finalize its race and when the pre-start of the next age group will begin! In the age groups U13 to U17 a joint start of male and female starters is planned. In all likelihood, the start will be delayed by one minute. From the U17, all starts are completed in the respective age and gender groups.

2.1 DAILY AND OVERALL AWARD CEREMONY

The last race of the season takes place in Koppl with the Nockstein Trophy as part of the Austria Youngsters Cup and the Austrian Mountain Bike League. Accordingly, there is not only an award ceremony for the race, but also a cup award ceremony. We want to celebrate this with the 25th anniversary of the Union Mountainbike Club Koppl. As in the previous year, the award ceremony will take place close to the Technical Assistance Zone (TAZ) next to the two blue containers.

Dependent on the weather and lighting conditions, the award ceremony will either be in front of or within a larger garage. Both, the garage, and the terrain outside we will also use for the closing party. In addition to music, light effects and a larger bar, Roland Pirker and his team will provide delicious BBQ food in his smoker. It's not just about meat, but also about vegetables and vegan food.

2.2 PRIZE MONEY FOR THE AUSTRIA YOUNGSTERS CUP

In the Austria Youngsters Cup, trophies are awarded for 1st place from the U13 to the U17. In addition, prize money of EUR 510 will be distributed (Table 2).

A total of EUR 2,850 will be distributed. In addition, the winner receives a trophy.
